- ✓ Attendance at all sessions
- ✓ Passing score for riding and knowledge tests

Rider Capability

- ✓ All students must be physically and mentally capable of controlling a motorcycle.
- ✓ In the event the RiderCoaches deem a rider to be a safety risk to self or other riders, he or she will be asked to step out of the class. There will be NO REFUND of fees.

- ✓ Waiver of the written and riding test when applying for motorcycle endorsement

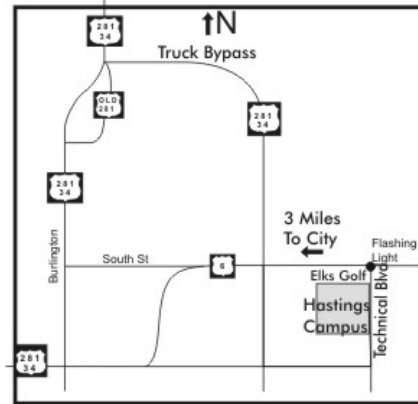


The Basic Rider Course utilizes two motorcycle models, the GN 125cc Suzuki and the 250cc

Nighthawk. They are standard motorcycle design. They are center control mounted motorcycles with a 28" seat height, and will require at least 100 degree knee and hip flexion.
